## Purpose of the role:

As an Apprentice Finance Assistant, you will help with organising accounting documents, assist with preparing financial statements and gain an overview of all finance administration tasks within a school.

Working within a finance team led by a CFO and reporting into a Finance Officer, the successful apprentice will assist with a wide variety of tasks including supporting:

- Sales ledger accounts
- To provide information to staff on budgets and balances
- To raise payments against properly agreed invoices
- To produce monthly debtors' reports
- Purchase ordering
- Maintain details of contracts, subscriptions and records of all DD and SO payments
- Assist with trips accounts and prizes accounts

- Weekly teaching delivered through a hybrid delivery model of classroom and remote learning apprentices will be required to attend our Peterborough Campus for the classroom delivery
